




**New Initiatives** 

- **1. NORMALIZE:** Program works by underrepresented composers throughout your season, not just on a single dedicated concert.
- 2. PRIORITIZE: Intentionally plan for a strong number of works by women composers and composers from underrepresented heritages in your seasons (we suggest at least 15-25% for each in a season) and at least one work for singular events..
- **3. AMPLIFY:** Allow a broader selection of voices on your concerts by limiting works per season by commonly performed composers (avoiding 3 or more).
- **4. PUBLICIZE:** Feature underrepresented composers in your marketing materials as visibly as you publicize more commonly programmed composers.


